

LIBRARY POSTER COMPETITION



You're invited to design a poster that tells us what you love about your library. From the benefits of reading to the welcome feeling you get when walking through the doors, what is it that makes the library important to you? Selected designs will go on public display at the Elma Turner Library so everyone can see what it is that makes our library such an important part of the community.

There are three categories and a winner will be selected for each: Ages 13 – 18
Ages 18 and over

Ngā Whare Mātauranga o Whakatū (all ages): One thing we love about New Zealand is our Māori heritage. We would like to see this heritage incorporated into a design which displays our Te Reo name - Ngā Whare Mātauranga o Whakatū

Entries will be judged by a panel of selected representatives from the Nelson City Council, Nelson Public Libraries and Arts Council Nelson. One submission will be selected for each category and these three designs will be made into an A1 size poster. The posters will be displayed in the Elma Turner Library windows for an undetermined period of time, and occasionally thereafter.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENTRIES

Designs must be A3 size (297 x 420 mm). The winning entries will be displayed as an A1 poster size (594 x 841 mm).

Artwork must be original to the person on the entry form and unpublished. Only one entry per person please.

Drawing, painting, graphic design, printmaking, or any combination of these media may be submitted. Entrants are welcome to include any text they see relevant.

By entering, participants are giving Nelson City Council permission to add their logo to their design should it be selected as a winning entry.

All decisions will be made by the selection panel and these decisions will be final.

All entries must be handed in at the Elma Turner, Stoke or Nightingale Library no later than 6pm Sunday, August 5. Please note no electronic submissions will be accepted.

When you deliver your entry to the library, please fill out the attached form to submit with your design.

Finalists will be notified by Friday, 24 August and encouraged to attend the launch of the poster on 30 August.

All artwork will be returned, please pick up from the Elma Turner Library no later than 30 September.

You are welcome to include a brief statement in the space opposite (300 words maximum) explaining how the entry meets the competition theme.
